

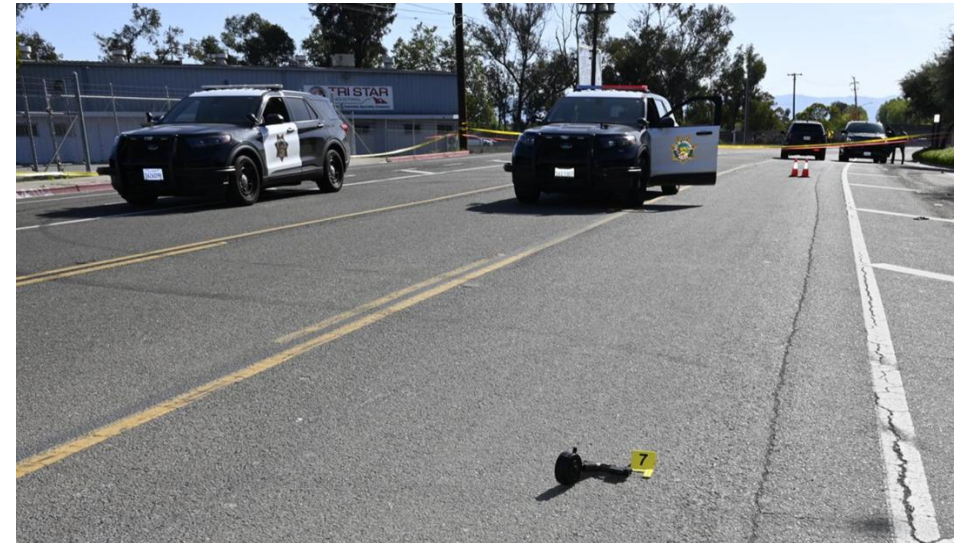
2025 Investigation Highlights

Robbery – Cross-jurisdictional Pursuit and Apprehension (April 2025)

- An armed bank robbery in Concord escalated into a multi-jurisdictional pursuit traveling south on I-680
- Two carjackings during pursuit (one attempted, one completed) in Sunol
- Special needs child safely rescued from vehicle prior to suspects fleeing
- Pursuit to San Jose where suspects flee on foot and one suspect tries to carjack another vehicle
- Officer-involved shooting which resulted in one suspect arrested
- The second suspect apprehended nearby with \$18,000 stolen from the bank
- Both suspects had extensive violent criminal histories (one on parole and one on probation)
- Case closed with felony charges for robbery, carjacking, and fully automatic assault weapons

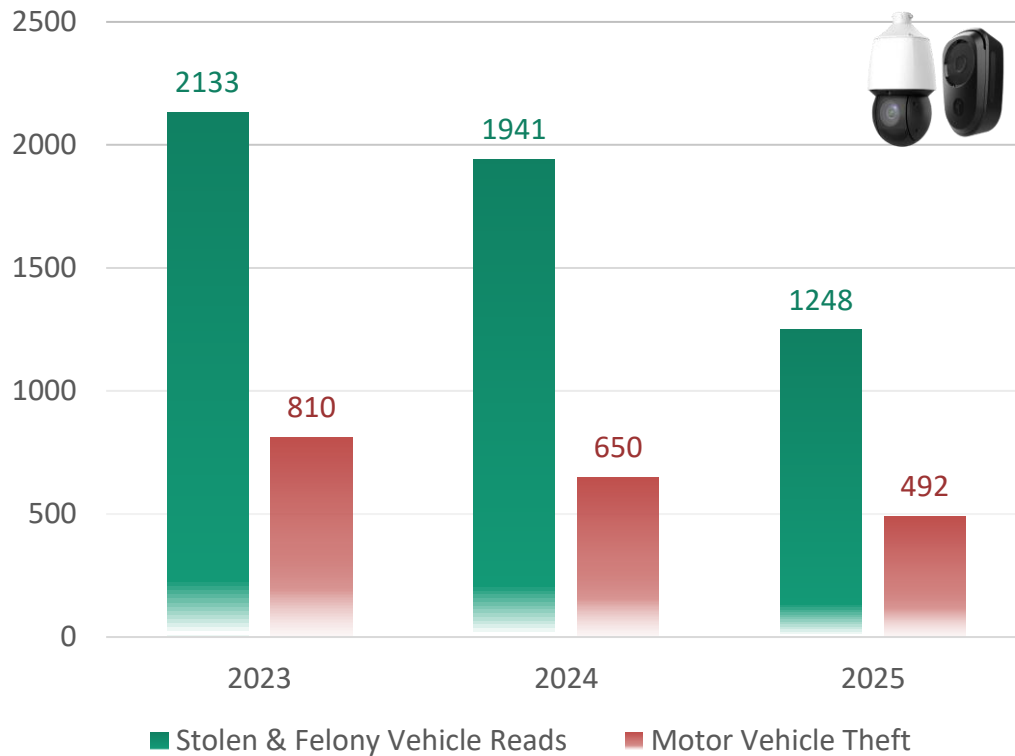
Homicide – Tech-driven Investigative Effort (April 2025)

- Homicide victim found shot in the parking lot at 1500 Monument Boulevard
- Video surveillance captured the event
- Flock ALPR data was used to identify the suspect vehicle
- Both suspects were identified and arrested
- Cell phones placed suspects at the scene
- Case made without eye-witness accounts
- Primary suspect is in custody and awaiting trial for murder

Road Rage Shooting (January 17, 2025)

- 22-year-old suspect fired a .45 caliber handgun at the victim's vehicle during a road rage incident. Charges included PC 245(A)(2) Assault with Firearm and PC 246 Shoot at Inhabited Dwelling/Vehicle.
- ALPR/Flock Role: Investigative resources included FLOCK LPR leads that were essential in identifying and locating the suspect vehicle.
- Outcome: Suspect arrested; case closed with felony complaint obtained.

Armed Home Invasion Robbery with Shooting (March 5, 2025)

- Armed suspects with a shotgun and handgun invaded a home in Concord and fired at the victim's residence, where a 2-month-old baby was present. The case involved possible gang-related connections and drugs.
- ALPR/Flock Role: 7-Eleven video first identified two suspect vehicles. Both vehicles were confirmed via FLOCK and entered into the Stolen Vehicle System (SVS). CHP Oakland later recovered the Infiniti in Oakland with 2 subjects while SFPD located the Lexus with 1 male and 1 juvenile male. All suspects were arrested.
- Outcome: Case closed - Felony complaint obtained for multiple suspects.
