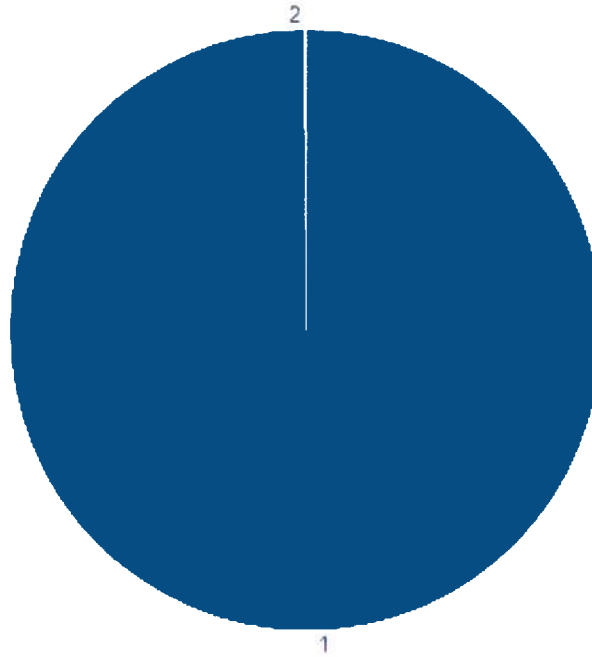

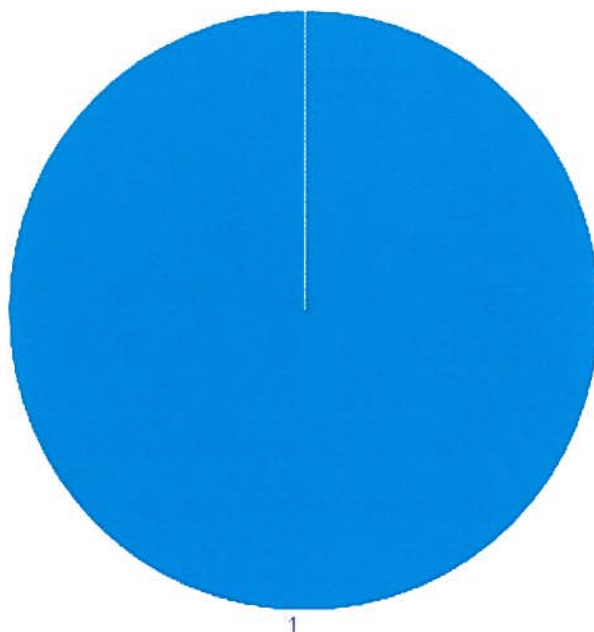

Pursuant to the California Public Records Act, I hereby request the following records:

To do this, a user may simply go to the "Sharing" section of LEARN and select "Output Report." A CSV/XLS file containing these records would also satisfy this request.
